Biographical Note on Christos Kyriakou

Christos Kyriakou was born in the occupied village of Larnakas Lapithou on June 6th 1956. He was the fourth out of five children of Stylianos and Finikou Kakoulli. He graduated from the Technical School of Nicosia and joined the National Guard at the beginning of 1974, at the age of 17 and a half. In July 1974, having been promoted to sergeant, he gave his first battle with the 33rd Commando Squadron in Agios Ilarionas, where he was wounded on the leg. After receiving treatment he returned to his squadron and continued fighting in the area of the Praxandros Gymnastics Association, where he was last seen. He was captured in Kazafani and executed in cold blood along with other brave men of his squadron. His remains were found in a mass grave in Kazafani in 2007.
